Minutes of the Business Session of the 123rd Annual Meeting
April 29, 2022 – National Shrine of Saint John Paul II

State Deputy Christopher Pierno, FDD, PGK, called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. and State Chaplain Rev. Frank S. Donio, S.A.C., D.Min opened the meeting with a prayer.

I. Opening and Administrative Items

- a. State Deputy Christopher Pierno welcomed the following special guests and Columbian Dignitaries:

- b. State Deputy Pierno then specifically recognized Fr. Donio for concelebrating the opening Mass.
- c. The State Deputy then appointed Past State Deputy Timothy Saccoccia as the Parliamentarian for the Annual Meeting.

d. Regularity of Credentials

- i. State Secretary Le Nguyen, FDD, PGK, PFN delivered the report as follows:

- ii. State Deputy Pierno moved for adoption which received sufficient second and was approved.

e. Appointment of Standing Committees

- i. State Deputy Pierno appointed the committees of the convention as it was reflected in the convention materials (attached).

f. Report of the Committee on Credentials

- i. State Secretary Nguyen reported that of the 52 members of the State Council entitled to a vote at the convention, 37 were present as follows:

Grand Knights/Alternates: 19
Past Grand Knights/Alternates: 10
- ii. State Secretary Nguyen moved for the adoption of his report which received sufficient second and was approved.

g. Greetings to the Convention

- i. State Deputy Pierno announced that greetings had been received by the following which were presented to the convention online by the following:

- ii. Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly was then introduced to deliver his remarks.

h. Approval of the Minutes of the 122nd Annual Meeting

- i. State Secretary Nguyen moved that the minutes of the 122nd annual meeting, which were included in the convention package, be approved. The motion received sufficient second and was approved by voice vote.

II. Reports of State Officers

a. State Deputy

- i. State Deputy Pierno turned control of the meeting to State Secretary Nguyen who introduced State Deputy Pierno for the Report of the State Deputy.
 1. The State Advocate moved that that convention extend its sincere appreciation and gratitude to the State Deputy for his timely message and that his report be received and filed. The motion received sufficient second and was approved by voice vote.
- ii. State Secretary Nguyen returned control of the meeting to the State Deputy.

b. State Treasurer

- i. State Treasurer M. Fred Armstrong, FDD, PGK, PFN delivered the report and moved for its adoption. A sufficient second was received and the motion carried.

V. Elections

State Deputy Pierno proceeded to the election of State Officers and turned the gavel over to the State Secretary.

a. State Deputy

- i. The State Secretary recognized Brother Sylvester Giustino standing in for the Chairman of the Nominations Committee, who nominated Christopher Pierno of Potomac Council #433.
- ii. The State Secretary called for further nominations, but none were entered.
- iii. The State Secretary recognized Brother Sylvester Giustino standing in for the Nominations Committee Chairman who moved that the State Treasurer be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot in the name of Christopher Pierno for the Office of State Deputy. The motion received sufficient second and was agreed to by voice vote.
- iv. The State Secretary then returned the gavel to the State Deputy to continue running the meeting.

b. State Secretary

- i. The State Deputy recognized Brother Sylvester Giustino standing in for the Chairman of the Nominations Committee, who nominated Le N. Nguyen of Sacred Heart Council #16215 for State Secretary.
- ii. The State Deputy called for further nominations, but none were entered.
- iii. The State Deputy recognized the Nominations Committee Chairman who moved that the State Warden be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot in the name of Le N. Nguyen for the Office of State Secretary. The motion received sufficient second and was agreed to by voice vote.

c. State Treasurer

- i. The State Deputy recognized Brother Sylvester Giustino standing in for the Chairman of the Nominations Committee, who nominated Nicholas S. C. Shields of St. John Paul II Council #16773 for State Treasurer.
- ii. The State Deputy called for further nominations, but none were entered.
- iii. The State Deputy recognized the Nominations Committee Chairman who moved that the State Warden be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot in the name of Nicholas S. C. Shields for the Office of State Treasurer. The motion received sufficient second and was agreed to by voice vote.

d. State Advocate

- i. The State Deputy recognized Brother Sylvester Giustino standing in for the Chairman of the Nominations Committee, who nominated Joshua R. Bryant of St. John Paul II Council #16773 for State Advocate.
- ii. The State Deputy called for further nominations, but none were entered.
- iii. The State Deputy recognized the Nominations Committee Chairman who moved that the State Secretary be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot in the name of Joshua R. Bryant for the Office of State Advocate. The motion received sufficient second and was agreed to by voice vote.

e. State Warden

- i. The State Deputy recognized the recognized Brother Sylvester Giustino standing in for the Chairman of the Nominations Committee, who nominated Ryan Mulvey of St. Josaphat Council #7530 for State Warden.
- ii. The State Deputy called for further nominations, but none were entered.
- iii. The State Deputy recognized the Nominations Committee Chairman who moved that the State Warden be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot in the name of Ryan Mulvey for the Office of State Warden. The motion received sufficient second and was agreed to by voice vote.

VI. Election of Delegates and Alternates to the Supreme Convention

State Deputy Pierno proceeded to the election of Delegates and Alternates to the Supreme Convention.

- a. In addition to its State Deputy and last living Past State Deputy, the District of Columbia is afforded one (1) additional delegate to the 140th Annual Meeting of the Supreme Council to represent its associate membership. Brother Le N. Nguyen of Council #16215 was elected on a unanimous ballot as the Associate Delegate to the Supreme Convention.
- b. Brother Knights were elected alternates to the delegates to the 140th Annual Meeting of the Supreme Council by unanimous ballots as follows:
 - i. Alternate to the State Deputy: Timothy M. Saccoccia of Council 16773
 - ii. Alternate to the Immediate Past State Deputy: George W. Hanna of Council 11578.
 - iii. Alternate to the Associate Delegate: Peter D. Gervais of Council 353.

The business session recessed for lunch and the annual meeting of DC Knights of Columbus Charities at approx. 12:15pm. The business session returned to order at approx. 12:45pm.

VII. Resolutions

- a. State Advocate Nicholas S. C. Shields delivered the report of the resolutions committee. The delegates to the convention approved of all recommendations made by the committee on the resolutions presented.

IX. The State Deputy asked the convention to express its thanks to State Treasurer M. Fred Armstrong for his many years of dedicated service to the DC State Council. He is moving out of the jurisdiction and can no longer serve as a State Officer. The State Deputy presented him with a plaque.

X. The State Deputy recognized the State Secretary for announcements regarding the close of the Convention and related activities taking place on Sunday, May 1. At the conclusion of the business meeting, the State Deputy thanked all delegates and officers for their assistance in executing the meeting and recognized Past State Deputy Peter Gervais, Director of Operations at the St. John Paul II Shrine and thanked him for all his assistance in pulling off the weekend's events. The State Deputy also thanked the staff of the St. John Paul II National Shrine for serving as the host of the convention.

XI. The closing prayer was delivered by the State Deputy. The State Deputy adjourned the business session of the 122nd Annual Meeting, sine die, at approx. 2:00 p.m.
